

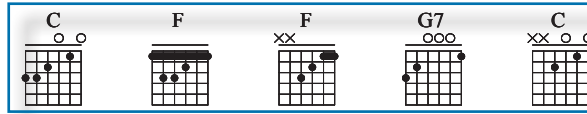
Key to starting out this intermediate tab song is to first play it slowly and very consistently. You can set the tempo in the Guitar Pro file as slow as you want and then set the speed trainer to increase in percentage increments. Rhythm section is provided for you on each song for your convenience.

Capo is placed on the 2nd fret to play in the key of "D Major" in lieu of "C Major"



These are all the chords used in this tab.

These notes before the score begins are referred to as pickup notes

Watch your down-up strokes in this passage of eighth notes especially when a pulloff is thrown into the mix!

I can't stress this enough to get each and every up and down stroke absolutely correct. This is quite a hard song and you need to master the down-ups. All of the ho's po's and slides can really mess you up!

Let these notes ring through each other as much as you can.

Crosspicking passage here. Down pick on second string up pick on first

This is a triplet with a hammer-on to kick-off the triplet. Catch the last note with an upstroke of the pick.

Reverse slide here. Watch it.

Remember to adjust your down-up picking to accommodate the pulloff, slides and hammer-ons.

First and Second endings to a passage. Play through the first ending up to the repeat bar and play a second time. The second time skip the first ending and play the second one, then continue.
